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MUNUTES OF THE GENERAL BODY MEETING OF CENTRAL GOVT. EMPLOYEES' WELFARE CO-ORDINATION COMMITTEE (CGEWCC) HELD IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF OCEAN TECHNOLOGY, DOLLYGUNJ, PORT BLAIR ON 13-01-2017 AT 15 30 HRS.

At the outset the Chairman welcomed the gathering and informed that the General Body meeting could not be held on 30-11-2016 due to poor attendance of members and the same is convened in the NIOT. Dr. N.V. Vinith Kumar, Officer-in-Charge, NIOT gave presentation about the activities of the NIOT, Port Blair which is very useful to many of the departments and the same would be uploaded in CGEWCC website. Chairman requested other departments to utilize the technology in their day to-day activities of NIOT. The agenda points were discussed as under.

1. Review of the minutes of meeting held on 30-11-2016:

1.1. Annual Subscription: The Chairman mentioned that as decided in the last meeting, D.O letter dated 03-10-2016 issued along with details of subscription paid / yet to be paid for the year 2014, 2015 & 2016 to all C.G departments. In response to this, Ayush, DOT, NSSO, ICMR, MMD, NIOT and CIPMC (PPO), Coconut Development, BSI, ISRO, Special Bureau and Pr. Director of Audit have remitted the annual subscription. The Chairman further appealed that the annual subscription is the only source of income which is being utilized for conducting indoor & outdoor games, Cultural programme, prizes etc. Therefore, the remaining departments which have not remitted the annual subscription are requested to make special drive to collect and remit the same as per the details mentioned in the above D.O letter.

1.2. CGEWCC Web site (<http://cgewcc.and.nic.in>): The Chairman informed that out of 56 C.G departments, only 15 departments (AIR, ALHW, ASI, Ayurveda Tribal Health Care Research Project, BSI, CIARI, CRI(H), DAVP, LHLS, MET office, NIC, NSSO, PIB, RMRC, FSI and ZSI) have submitted the details of their achievements for uploading in CGEWCC website. He requested that all the remaining departments to send the write-up containing their activities, mandates, targets, achievements, website details along with photographs to upload the same. Those departments which have already furnished the details, may send photos and brief of their department to NIC for updating the same from time to time.

1.3. Annual Day Function: The Chairman informed that the Annual Day will be celebrated on 10-02-2017 subject to availability of the Chief Guest. Letter sent to the Chief Secretary seeking appointment for inviting as Chief Guest for the function.

1.4. **Reimbursement of airfare to entitled officers by air restricting to ship fare:** The Chairman mentioned that the Ministry of Finance has informed that powers have been delegated to Financial Advisors of Ministries/Departments concerned to grant relaxation on air fare and our request for delegating powers to Head of Departments based at Port Blair considering the geographical conditions and remoteness of A & N Islands has not acceded to. It was decided to take up the matter again and would be discussed with concerned officer in the Ministry of Finance during visit to New Delhi.

1.5. **Central Govt. Employees Welfare Housing Scheme:** The Chairman mentioned that the demand of applications received so far is not sufficient to take up matter with the CGEWS and suggested that a committee comprising Shri Sandana Edward, Area Welfare Officer, Shri Senthil, CPWD and two staff members from ALHW will make a special drive and visit the remaining departments which have not submitted the applications for housing scheme on 8th & 9th February 2017 and collect the same. All the HoDs are requested to cooperate the committee members in obtaining the filled application from their staff.

1.6. **Swachh Bharat Abhiyan:** Chairman informed that next Swachh Bharat Abhiyan will be organized and the venue and date will be intimated in due course. He further mentioned that Padma Shree Naresh Chander Lal, Swachh Bharat Ambassador, Andaman made a surprise visit to ALHW office and Guest House on 13-01-2017.

2. **Finalization of Holiday list for the year 2017:** The Holiday list for the year 2017 was finalized wherein one Restricted Holiday on 30-12-2017 included on the eve of Commemoration of flag hoisted by Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose on 30-12-1943 at Port Blair and circulated. The A & N Administration also issued the Holiday list for the year 2017 with some changes which is suiting to CG employees also. Hence, it was unanimously agreed to make an amendment in the Holiday list for 2017 i.e. 30-12-2017 will be Public Holiday instead of Restricted Holiday and accordingly, **Revised Holiday list** is enclosed herewith.

3. **Charging of CGHS rates for C.G employees by the AMAs:** The Chairman informed that CGHS rates are to be charged by the AMAs towards treatment, tests, X-ray etc. for the Central Govt. employees as being followed in hospitals at Mainland. Hence, it was decided to adopt the same procedure at Port Blair also and this will be intimated to all AMAs to follow. The AMAs shall also display the board mentioning as "Authorized AMA for Central Govt. employees".

As per the latest guidelines published in the Hand Book 2016, the limit of ten days treatment at the consulting room of AMA may be increased to forty days if the treatment is taken in Indian system of Medicines and in Homoeopathy. The total number of consultations will, however, remain four at an interval of ten days.

While issuing appointment / renewal to AMAs, the above two conditions would be incorporated in future. This will also be intimated to the Sub-Committee for appointment of AMAs.

4. **Conducting training/lecture by experts for C.G employees:** The Chairman mentioned that experts from various Central Govt. offices in Port Blair may forward their names giving the field of experience to deliver lecture/training on the subjects like RTI, Vigilance, Disciplinary proceedings, e-tendering, e-procurement, Ethics etc. for the benefit of C.G employees.

Shri K.N. Subba Reddy, JTO, DoT, who has agreed to give presentation on E-procurement, is presently on leave at mainland and the same will be presented on his arrival at the convenient date. Shri Goutam Gupta, NIC mentioned that he will give presentation on Cashless transaction and e-granthalaya in the next monthly meeting.

5. **Empanelment of private hospitals under CGHS scheme at Port Blair:** The Central Govt. employees are taking treatment at private hospitals/doctors who are authorized AMAs like Chakraborty Multi Specialty Hospital, Arun Hospital, Swasthya Medical Centre. These hospitals are having more than 10 beds for treatment and if these hospitals are empanelled under CGHS scheme, it will be more beneficial to C.G employees. This will be taken up very soon.

7. Any other points with permission of Chair:

i) Dr. M.S. Kundu, CIARI mentioned that CIARI is facing problems for downloading and uploading information due to poor network connectivity. The National Knowledge Network (NKN) connectivity has been extended to the ICMR by the NIC and the same may be provided to CIARI also to mitigate the network problem till BSNL network connectivity is improved. Shri Goutam Gupta, NIC mentioned that NKN connectivity has been provided to ICMR being the institute. The CIARI may apply for the NKN connectivity to the local State Information Officer, NIC, Port Blair with copy to the Head of the Department, National Knowledge Network, NIC HQ, New Delhi for exploring the possibility.

ii) Shri M.K. Anjanaiah, MSME mentioned that workshop, training etc. are being conducted by the CG departments and the same is not informed to other departments. Chairman requested all C.G departments that schedule of such trainings/workshops may be intimated to all connected departments so that they can participate and get the benefit.

iii) The infrastructure facilities available with each C.G department shall also be shared by other C.G departments stationed at Port Blair for better utility of the same. This was agreed in principle by the members present.

iv) Shri B. Toppo, CPWD has raised various grievances on service matters i.e. relaxation of transfer policy, change of office timings, grant of double HRA etc. Chairman informed that a representation may be submitted so as to take up as deemed fit, if necessary.


v) Allotment of accommodation for lease to run Anganwadi to CGEWCC:

The Secretary mentioned that the Directorate of Estates, New Delhi has issued O.M dated 11-08-2016 regarding allotment of accommodation for lease to CGEWCC to run the Anganwadi in the premises of GPRA at Port Blair and the Committee has requested to hand over the accommodation to the Programme Officer (ICDS), Dte. of Social Welfare, Port Blair vide letter dated 30-12-2016 but this has not been handed over so far. The Area Welfare Officer has been requested to sort out this issue with CPWD authorities.

The Chairman expressed sincere thanks to Dr. N.V. Vinith Kumar, Officer-in-Charge, NIOT for detailed presentation given and also arrangements made for the General Body meeting at the NIOT.

The meeting ended with cordial note.
