13TH MARCH, 2012 AT 1530 HRS.

Shri A.Justin, Secretary presided over the meeting in the absence of the Chairman and Vice-Chairman who are away to mainland on official duties.

While welcoming the members present, the Secretary expressed that attendance in the monthly meeting is very poor and requested the cooperation of all the members for the smooth functioning the Committee. Thereafter, the agenda points were taken up for discussions as under::

1. Review of the minutes of meeting held on 12.1.2012: As regards water supply to CPWD Colony, Shri S.Rajendra Prasad, Exe.Engineer, CWPD mentioned that water supply to the colony is meagre even during rainy reason leave alone the summer season and requested that the matter may be pursued at the highest level. After discussions, it was decided that a delegation consisting of Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Secretary and other members as given below will meet the Chief Secretary, Chairman,

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Municipal Council and Chief Engineer, APWD preferably on 27th March, 2012 to sort out the issue. The team of members is as follows:

As regards allotment of GPRA quarters, S.Rajendra Prasad, Exe.Engineer, CPWD mentioned that allotment of quarters to Coast Guard may have to be stopped as many Civilian employees are in waiting list and many officials could not be allotted with the entitled type of accommodation. Since Defence/Coast Guard organization is having a separate pool of accommodation of their own, no further allotment should be considered and the quarters fallen vacant should be allotted to the Civilian employees for whom the quarters were constructed. Shri S.Edward, NSSO narrated the efforts made by the Coordination Committee to get the land allotted in favour of CGEWCC as otherwise it would have gone to somebody else. It was also pointed out that nowhere in the country Civilian employees are allotted with accommodation in Defence colonies/establishments of their own pool.

1. **Annual Subscription** : Secretary mentioned that sizable amount has been spent for conducting the Sports Events and the balance fund available is very meagre. He also informed that only 11 departments have so far paid the annual subscription for the year 2011-12 and requested all the departments to send the subscription urgently. It was also decided to have a Committee headed by Shri D.Sathyamoorthy, Sports & Cultural Coordinator (ALHW) with other members viz. Shri A.Justin, Secretary and Shri S.Edward, NSSO to mobilize funds to meet the expenditure in connection with celebration of Annual Day.

2. **Conducting of Annual Day**: Secretary appreciated the efforts of the Chairman and Shri D.Sathyamoorthy, Sports Coordinator and Shri Kishen Singh in conducting the Sports events in a marvelous way. After deliberations, it was tentatively decided to have the Annual Day function on 8th April, 2012(Sunday) at the **Multi-purpose Hall of ALHW near Fisheries Jetty, Phoenix Bay**. It was also decided that Hon'ble Lt.Governor may be invited to be the Chief Guest for the Annual Day Function. In case Hon'ble Lt.Governor is not available, the Chief Secretary, A & N Administration may be invited to be the Chief Guest. Dr.M.S.Kundu, Sr.Scientist, CARI has been requested to make arrangements for the Momento to be presented to the Chief Guest.

3. **Conducting of Cultural programmes**: Shri D.Sathamoorthy, Cultural Coordinator has been requested to organize suitable cultural programme to be staged/rehearsed at last a week before the Annual Day celebration. Shri Kishen Singh,

ALHW and other members as deemed fit may be co-opted to organize the cultural events. It was decided to give prizes to all the participants in the Cultural programme. Shri Kishen Singh, after consulting selected cultural troupes/performers should prepare master CD/DVD/Audio cassette to facilitate the cultural programmes on the ensuing Annual Day on 8th April, 2012.

4. **Any other items with the permission of Chair :**

Air travel by private Airlines by entitled Officers : It has been decided to request the Chairman to pursue the matter with the appropriate authorities as and when he visits New Delhi on official tour.

5. **NEXT MEETING** : The next meeting has been tentatively fixed during the first week of July, 2012 at the Conference Hall of Anthropological Survey of India, Port Blair. The exact date of date meeting will be intimated later on.

The meeting ended with cordial note.
