The Chairman welcomed the gathering, made a detailed power point presentation on RTI matters and further continued the proceedings of the meeting as under.

Review of minutes of the monthly meeting held on 29-09-2017:

- 1.1. **Annual Subscription:** The Secretary mentioned that even after repeated requests, the Annual subscription has not been remitted by the defaulting departments for which a D.O letter dated 03-10-2016 issued to all C.G departments along with details of subscription paid / yet to be paid for the year 2014, 2015 & 2016. As this is the only source of income which is being utilized for conducting indoor & outdoor games, Cultural programme, prizes etc., he once again requested all the HoDs to verify the list of annual subscription collected from the officers and staff of the above period including 2017 and remit the same as the annual subscription is the only source of income which is being utilized for conducting indoor & outdoor games, Cultural programme, prizes etc. The CIPMC and ZSI have remitted the subscription for the year 2017.
- 1.2. <u>CGEWCC Web site (http://cgewcc.and.nic.in)</u>: The Secretary informed that out of 56 C.G departments, only 15 departments (AIR, ALHW, ASI, Ayurveda Tribal Health Care Research Project, BSI, CIARI, CRI(H), DAVP, LHLS, MET office, NIC, NSSO, PIB, RMRC and FSI) have submitted the details of their achievements for uploading in CGEWCC website. He requested all the remaining departments to send the write-up and also those departments which have already furnished the details very long back may update the information and send photos & brief of their department to NIC by e-mail for updating the same from time to time. - 1.3. Annual Day Function: The Chairman mentioned that the Annual Day will be celebrated on 29th Dec. 2017 at the Multipurpose Hall of ALHW near Fisheries Jetty. The Chief Secretary, A & N Admn. will be invited as Chief Guest and in case preoccupied, the senior most officer among the Central Govt. Departments will be invited. A Cultural programme will also be held for which interested participants may inform their names over phone No.232864 (O) to P.S to Chairman. Rehearsals will be held on 23-12-2017 (Saturday) at 4 p.m. at the Multipurpose Hall of ALHW. A Circular is issued in this regard. The indoor games were conducted during Feb. 2016 and prizes will be given during this Annual day function.

- 1.4. Reimbursement of airfare to entitled officers by air restricting to ship fare: The Secretary mentioned that the Ministry of Finance has informed that powers have been delegated to Financial Advisors of Ministries/Departments concerned to grant relaxation on air fare and our request for delegating powers to Head of Departments based at Port Blair considering the geographical conditions and remoteness of A & N Islands has not acceded to. It was decided to take up the matter again and would be discussed with concerned officer in the Ministry of Finance during visit to New Delhi.
- 1.5. Central Govt. Employees Welfare Housing Scheme: The Secretary mentioned that the demand of applications for Housing scheme received so far 216 which is not sufficient to take up the matter with CGEWHO. Shri Sushil Kumar Singh, CIARI mentioned that action has already been initiated to collect the demand (format) from their staff and by Feb. 2017 the same will be forwarded to the Committee. All remaining departments have been requested to collect the demand (format) from their officers and staff and forward the same to the Committee at the earliest.
- 1.6. <u>Finalization of Holiday list for the year 2018</u>: The Holidays for the year 2018 have been finalized in consultation with the members present and enclosed herewith as <u>Annexure-I & II</u>.
- 1.7. <u>Conducting training/lecture by experts for C.G employees:</u>TheCentral Govt. offices in Port Blair may forward their names giving the field of experience to deliver lecture/training on the subjects like RTI, Vigilance, Disciplinary proceedings, e-tendering, e-procurement, Ethics etc. for the benefit of C.G employees which can be organized during monthly meetings.

- 1.8. <u>Empanelment of private hospitals under CGHS scheme at Port Blair:</u> There are no CGHS hospitals in Port Blair except AMAs. Hence, it was decided to take up the matter with the concerned Ministry.
- 1.9. <u>Appointment of AMA for Dental treatment</u>: Matter has been taken up with the M/o Health and Family Welfare for consideration of inclusion of Dentist as AMA and the reply is awaited.

2. Any other points with the permission of Chair:

2.1. Study tour to Zoological Survey of India: The Secretary mentioned that that an awareness seminar and study tour was organized for the school students from CPWD complex on 03-10-2017 to ZSI complex to create awareness about the activities of ZSI. Around 80 students along with their parents were participated. Dr. C. Sivaperuman, OIC, ZSI has extended full cooperation and hospitality. A detailed presentation on the activities of ZSI, faunal diversity of A & N Islands with special reference to Avifauna was made and also shared his experience of 36th Indian Scientific Expedition to Antarctica & importance of preservation of the polar Contd..P/4

ecosystem. He also discussed about the fauna, flora and climate of Antarctica and presented lecture including video of the Antarctica covering southern ocean and Indian Scientific Research Station at Antarctica. Photos of the visit have been uploaded in our website. The Secretary requested the remaining Central Govt. departments also to arrange such awareness seminar/study tour to the school students so as to create awareness about their activities. Shri N.V. Vinith Kumar, OIC, NIOT (Vice President, CGEWCC) has accepted the proposal of Secretary to arrange study tour. The NIOT may be contacted for fixing suitable date for the study tour for school students.
